1. Approve minutes of February 13, 2017

3. Requests or Comments from the public

- Gary Carpenter raised concern about land that Bonner Springs has sold at 110th Street and voiced opposition to any development putting in apartments. Mr. Carpenter also expressed his concern of Bonner Springs tapping into Edwardsville sewer line.
- Jeff Carson, realtor in the Kansas City area noted concerns regarding code enforcement throughout the City as he is trying to sell a home.

4. Hear presentation regarding the USD 204 2017 Bond Issue

- Dan Brungardt, Superintendent for USD 204, gave a presentation on the upcoming Bond issue for the school district.
- Mr. Brungardt reviewed the planned facility improvements at each of the affected schools in the district
- Also in attendance from the School District was David Tollan and Tim McGinnis.
