

ORDINANCE NO. 918

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS ("CODE"), CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 8.02, SECTION 8.02.003, SALE OR CONSUMPTION IN PUBLIC PLACE.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 8.02.003 of the Code of the City of Edwardsville is hereby amended to read as follows:


Sec. 8.02.003 Possession or Consumption on City Property

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to use, consume, or have on the premise of any park or other city-owned property within the city, any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage, except:
- 1) Alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverages may be possessed and consumed at the Community Center in pursuant to, and in compliance with, a rental agreement.
 - 2) Cereal malt beverages may be sold, possessed, and consumed in any park or other city-owned property within the city pursuant to, and in compliance with, a special event permit issued pursuant to the Code, and in effect for such premises.

Section 2. Original Section 8.02.003 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
