

**ORDINANCE NO. 946**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS (“CODE”), CHAPTER 4, SECTION 4.03.102 OCCUPATION TAX LEVIED; AMENDING APPENDIX A FEE SCHEDULE, SECTION A4.002 AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City may levy and collect a biennial occupation or license tax on any person or company holding a state issued retailer’s liquor license; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kansas Statute 41-310 (l)(1) provides for charges by local governments in an amount not less than \$200.00 nor more than \$600 biennial occupation or license tax.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS:**

Section 1. Section 4.03.102 of the Code of the City of Edwardsville is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4.03.102 Occupation tax levied

There is hereby levied a biennial occupation tax as provided for in the fee schedule found in the appendix of this code on any person holding a license issued by the state director of alcoholic beverage control for the retail sale within the city of alcoholic liquors for consumption off the premises. Such tax shall be paid by the retailer to the city clerk before business is begun under an original state license and shall be paid within five days after any renewal of a state license.

Section 2. Appendix A Fee Schedule, Article A4.000, Section A4.002, Sale of alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverages, of the Code of Ordinances, City of Edwardsville, Kansas is hereby amended by adding the following:

(c) Alcoholic Liquor Biennial Occupation Tax: \$400

Section 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
