

PROCLAMATION

OF A STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

FOR THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KS

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of March, 2020, I find that certain conditions have caused or imminently threaten to cause widespread illness, injury, or loss of life in disaster proportions in the City of Edwardsville, Kansas as the result of the impacts of the Novel Coronavirus 19 (CoVID -19); and

WHEREAS, such conditions hinder and endanger the health, safety, and welfare of persons and property within the County of Wyandotte, Kansas, including the City of Edwardsville; and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous to the health and safety of residents and persons within the City of Edwardsville to take necessary precautions to limit potential exposure to the Novel Coronavirus 19.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Edwardsville, Kansas by virtue of the authority vested in this office by K.S.A. 48-932, as amended, do hereby proclaim that a State of Local Disaster Emergency exists.

I DO HEREBY INVOKE any and all rights and/or powers to perform such functions as are vested in this office by and through the provisions of the Kansas Emergency Preparedness Act.

I DO HEREBY PROCLAIM that this Proclamation shall remain in effect for a period of seven (7) days from this date, unless terminated earlier, or renewed, by consent of the Edwardsville City Council.
