Applicant hereby understands that there must be some method of extinguishment on hand and that a competent person must be in constant attendance of the burning operation until all fire has been extinguished. Applicant also understands that he/she is responsible for any loss or damage that may occur from this burning operation. In the event that the fire grows out of control, applicant should immediately dial 911.

In accordance with city ordinances, this burning permit is only valid between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. and all fire must be extinguished by 7:00 P.M. The applicant understands that if the fire department has to respond to this burning operation due to it being unattended for burning after hours, or for burning unapproved materials; a citation may be issued as well as the loss of future burning privileges.

Burning is restricted to natural vegetation only described as weeds, trees, stumps and other natural vegetation. This excludes junk, lumber and all man-made materials. The burning of entire fields, vacant lots or bon fires is prohibited without special permission from the fire department.
