

ORDINANCE NO. 961

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THAT ALL ELECTIONS FOR THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS SHALL BE NONPARTISAN

WHEREAS, in 2015, the Kansas Legislature passed House Bill 2104, which made changes to the State's election laws; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 2104 allows the City to establish by regular ordinance whether elections shall be partisan or nonpartisan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Edwardsville desires to keep City elections nonpartisan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS

SECTION 1. All elections for the City of Edwardsville, Kansas shall be nonpartisan.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
