

ORDINANCE NO. 980

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KANSAS ESTABLISHING FEES FOR MINING AND QUARRYING ACTIVITIES AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, mining and quarrying activities are permitted through a special use permit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to establish a fee for such activities in conjunction with a special use permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE, KS:

SECTION 1. A fee shall be imposed based on the estimated volume of material to be removed in conjunction with the approval of a special use permit for mining and quarrying based on the following schedule:

|---------------------------------|------------------------|
| a) Sand and soil: | \$0.025 per cubic yard |
| b) Gravel and Rock (2" or less) | \$0.075 per ton |
| c) Rock (greater than 2") | \$0.150 per ton |

SECTION 2. Said fees shall be incorporated into Appendix A, Schedule of Fees, Edwardsville Code of Ordinances.


SECTION 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
